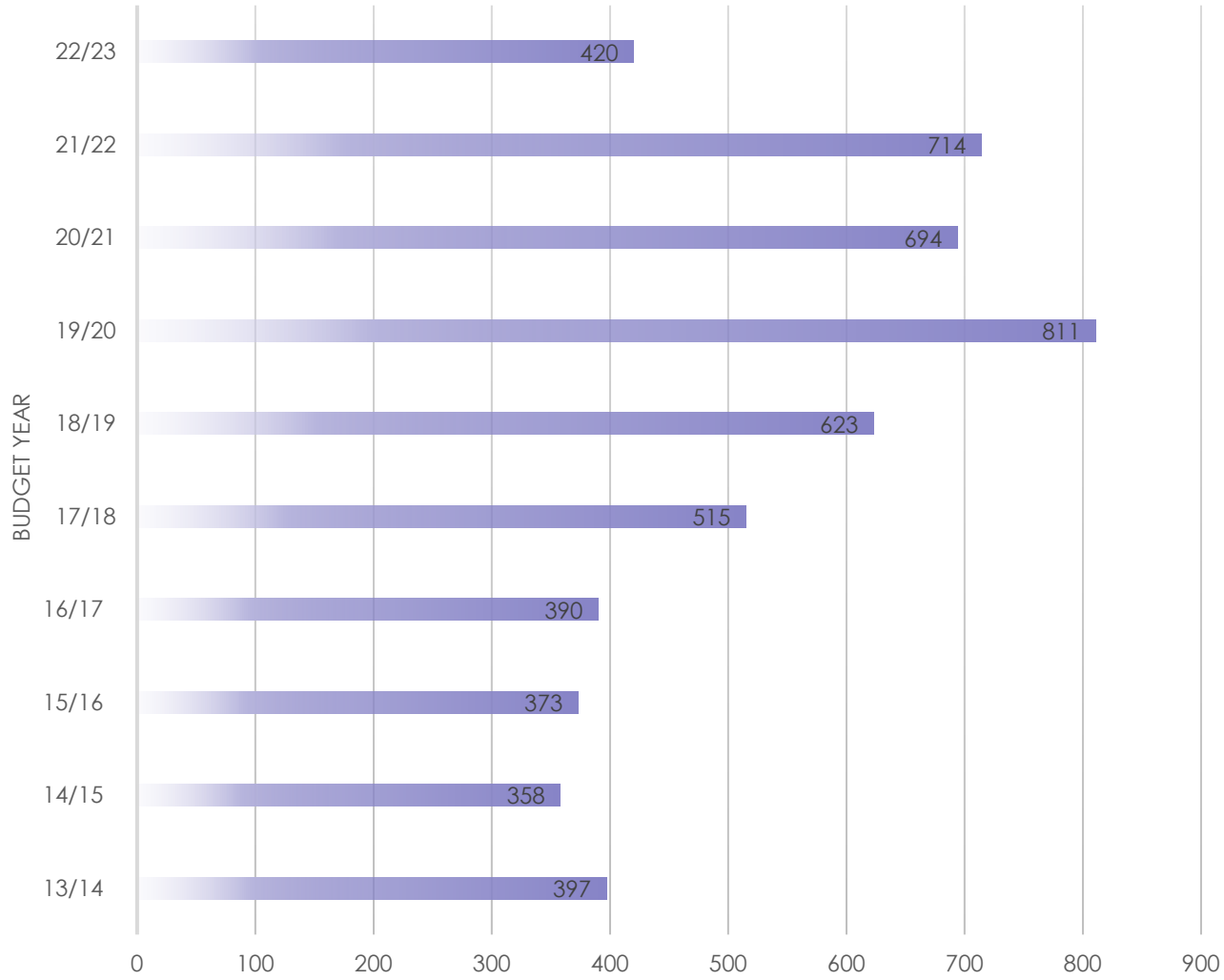

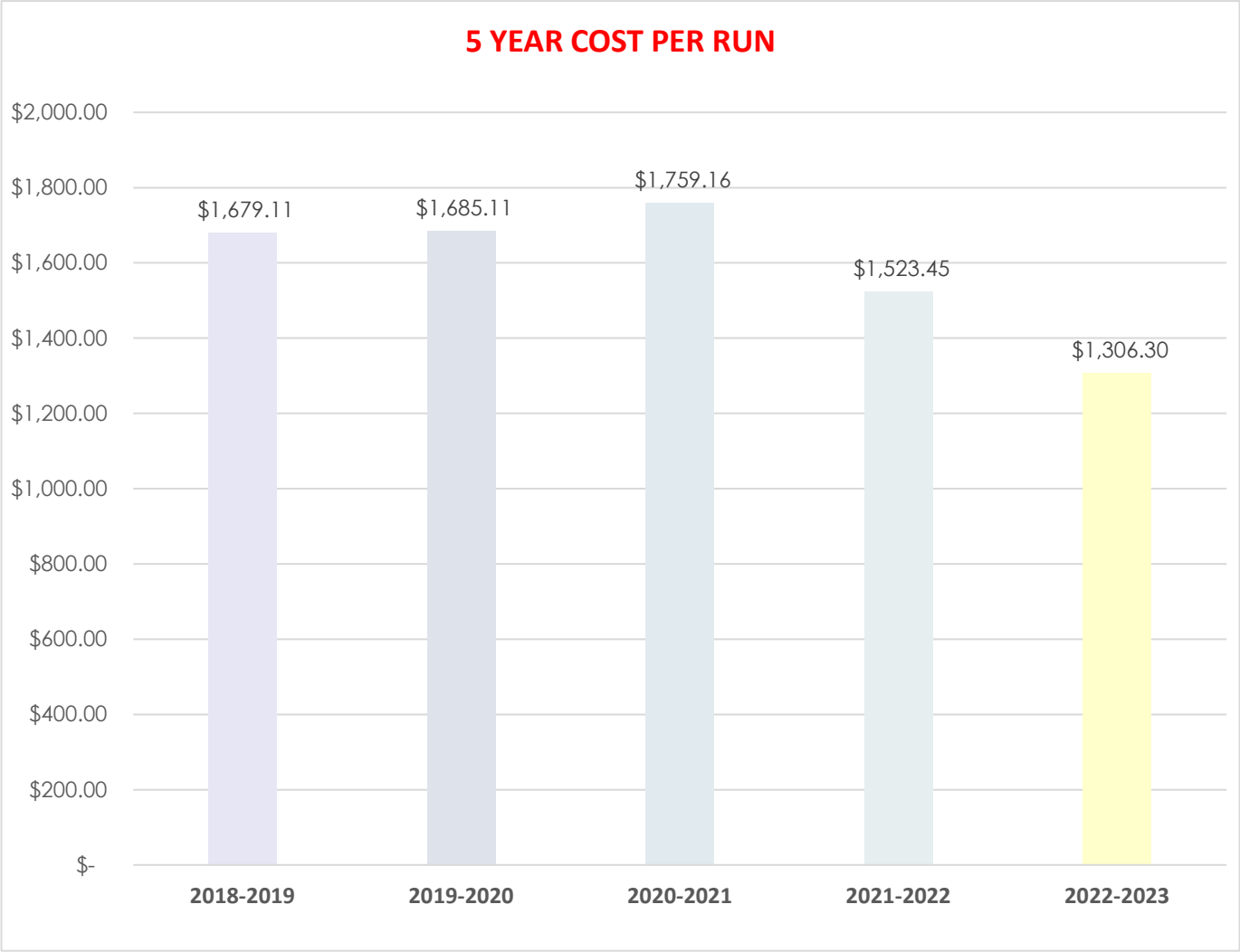

FIRE PREVENTION

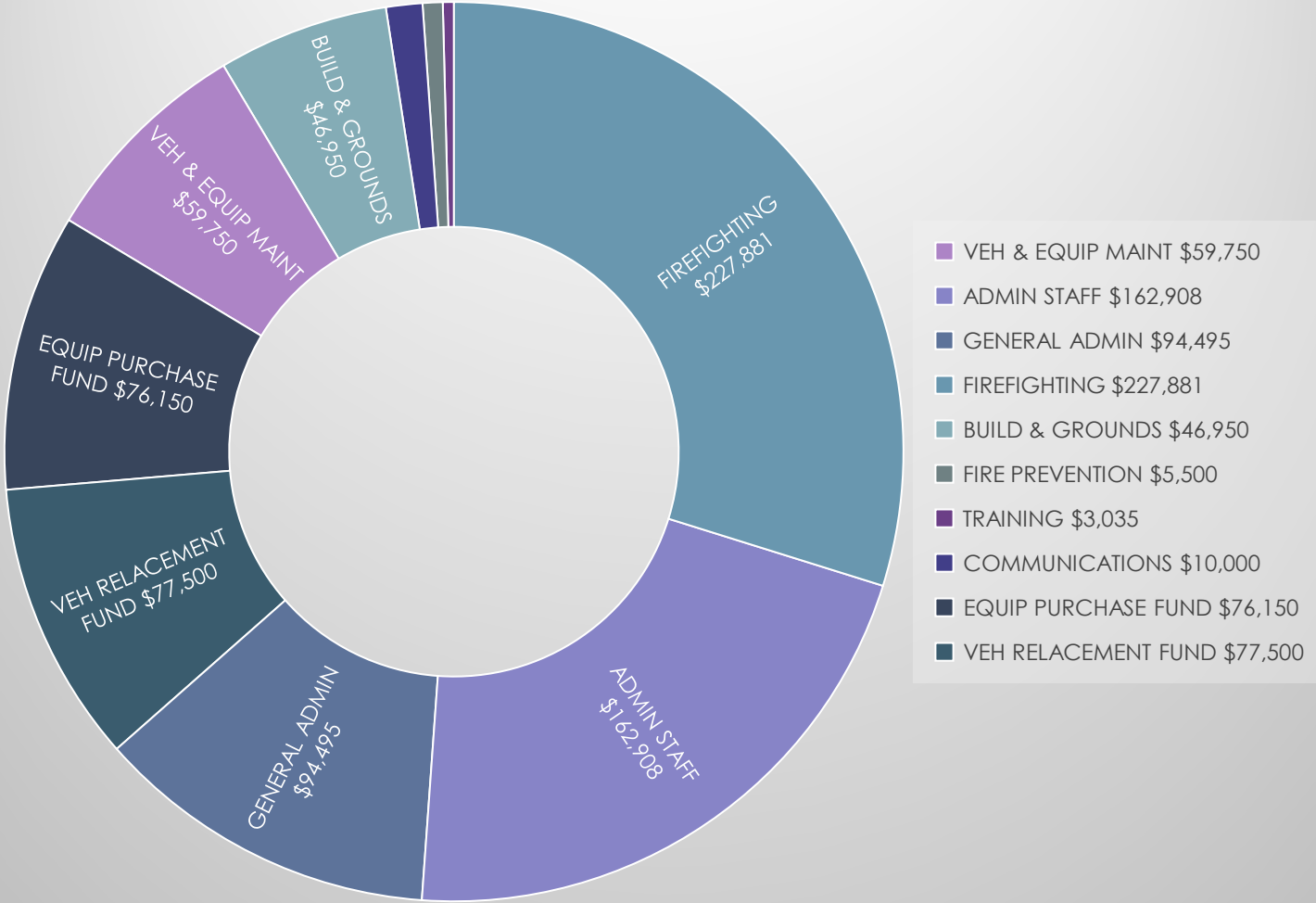

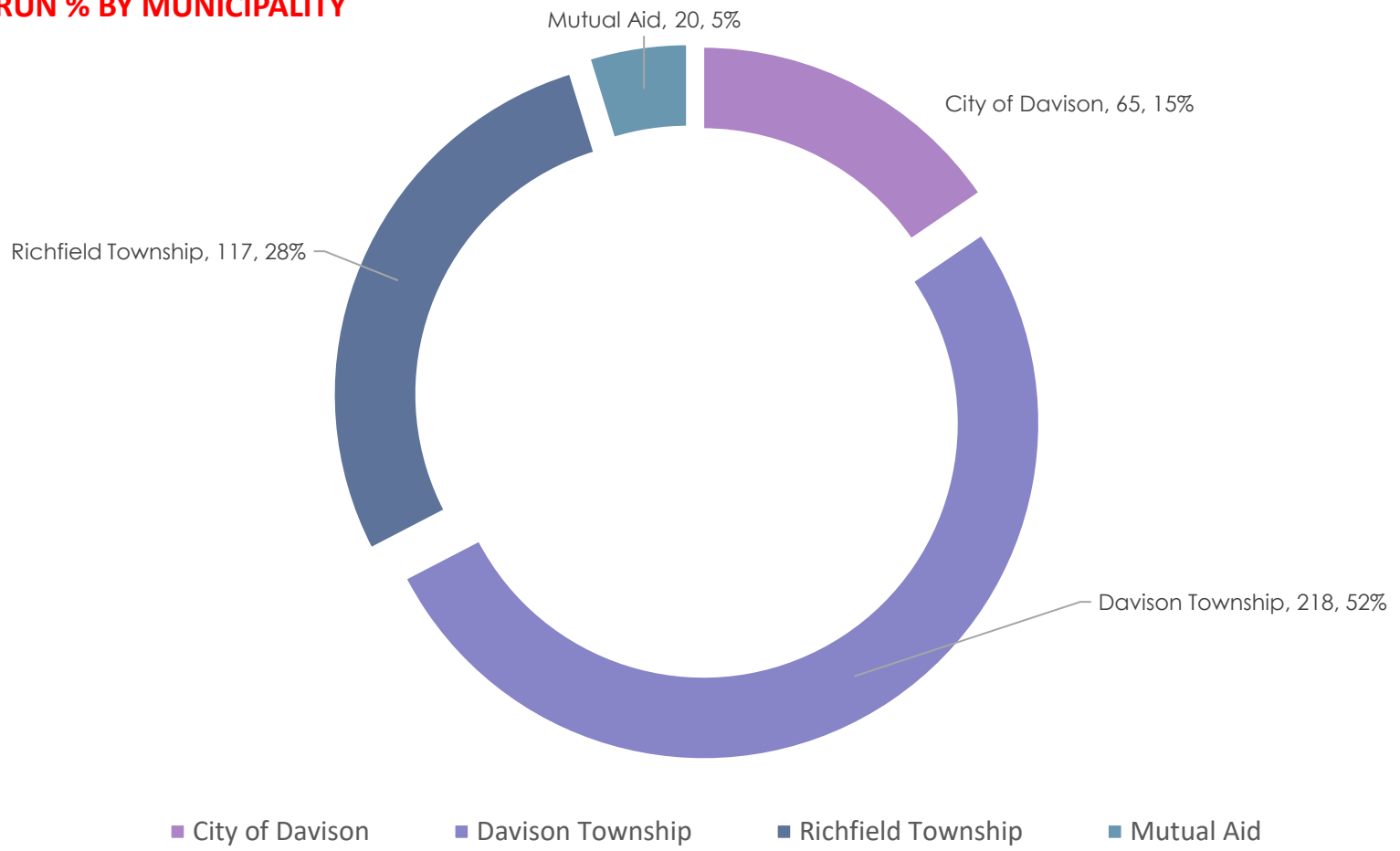

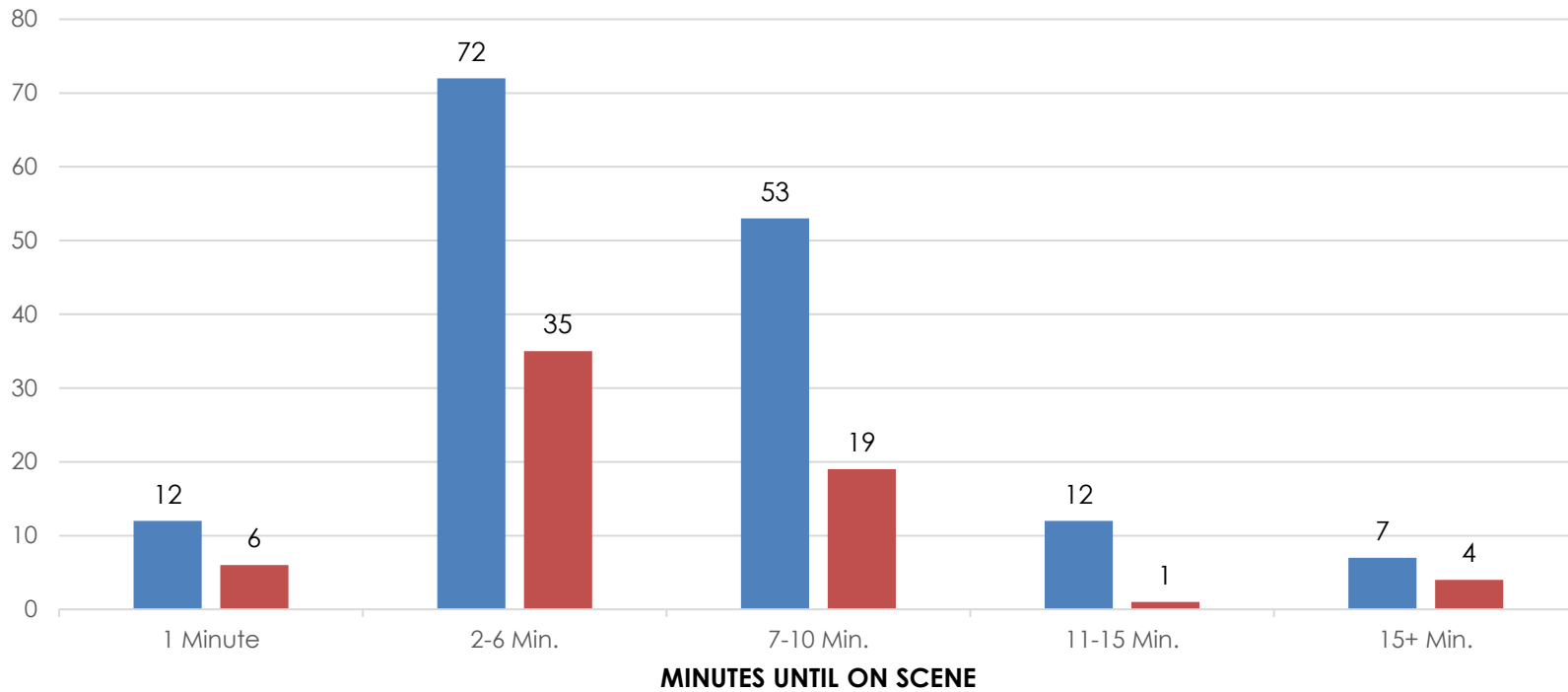
RUN % BY MUNICIPALITY

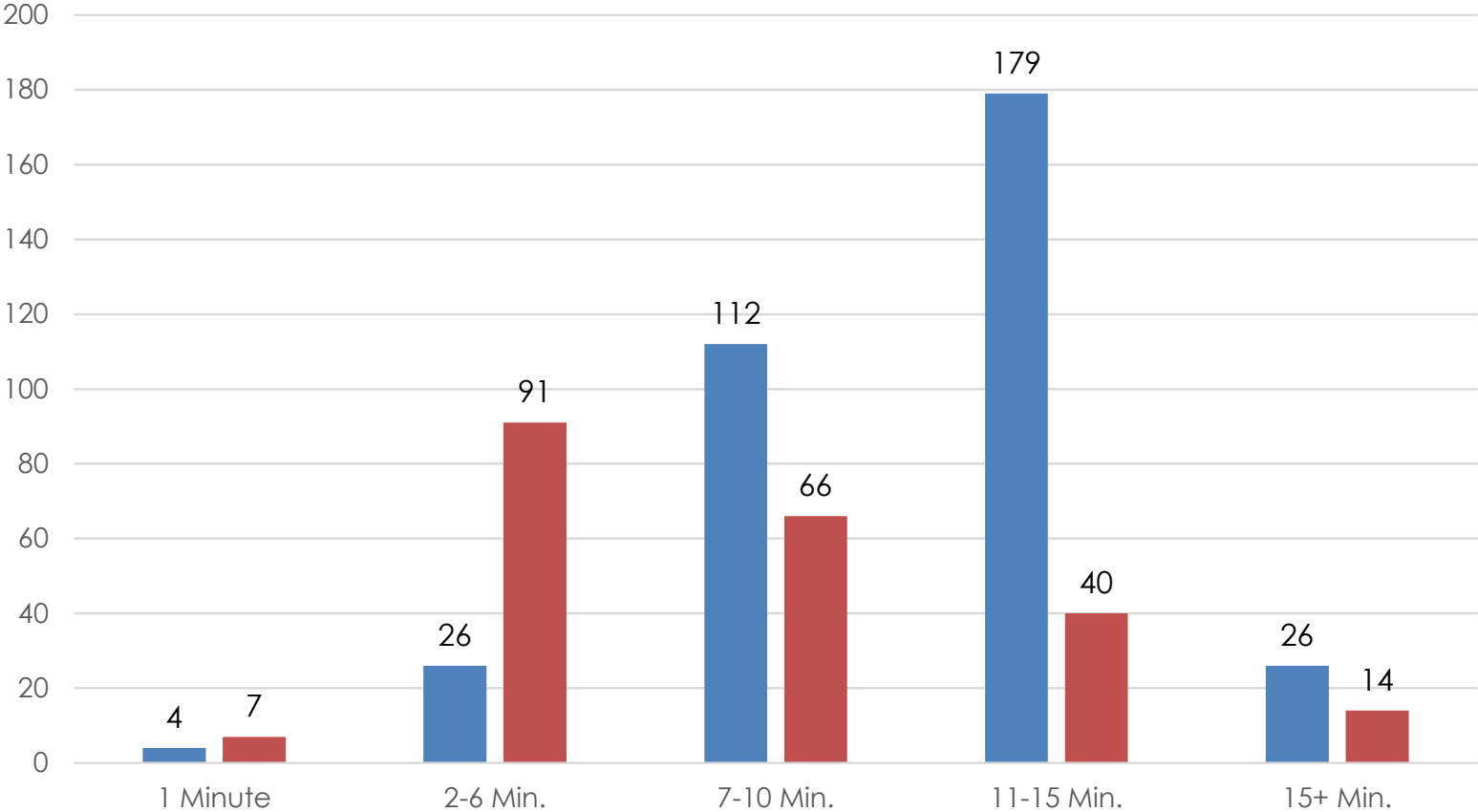
CITY OF DAVISON Response Time Comparison

DAVISON TOWNSHIP Response Time Comparison

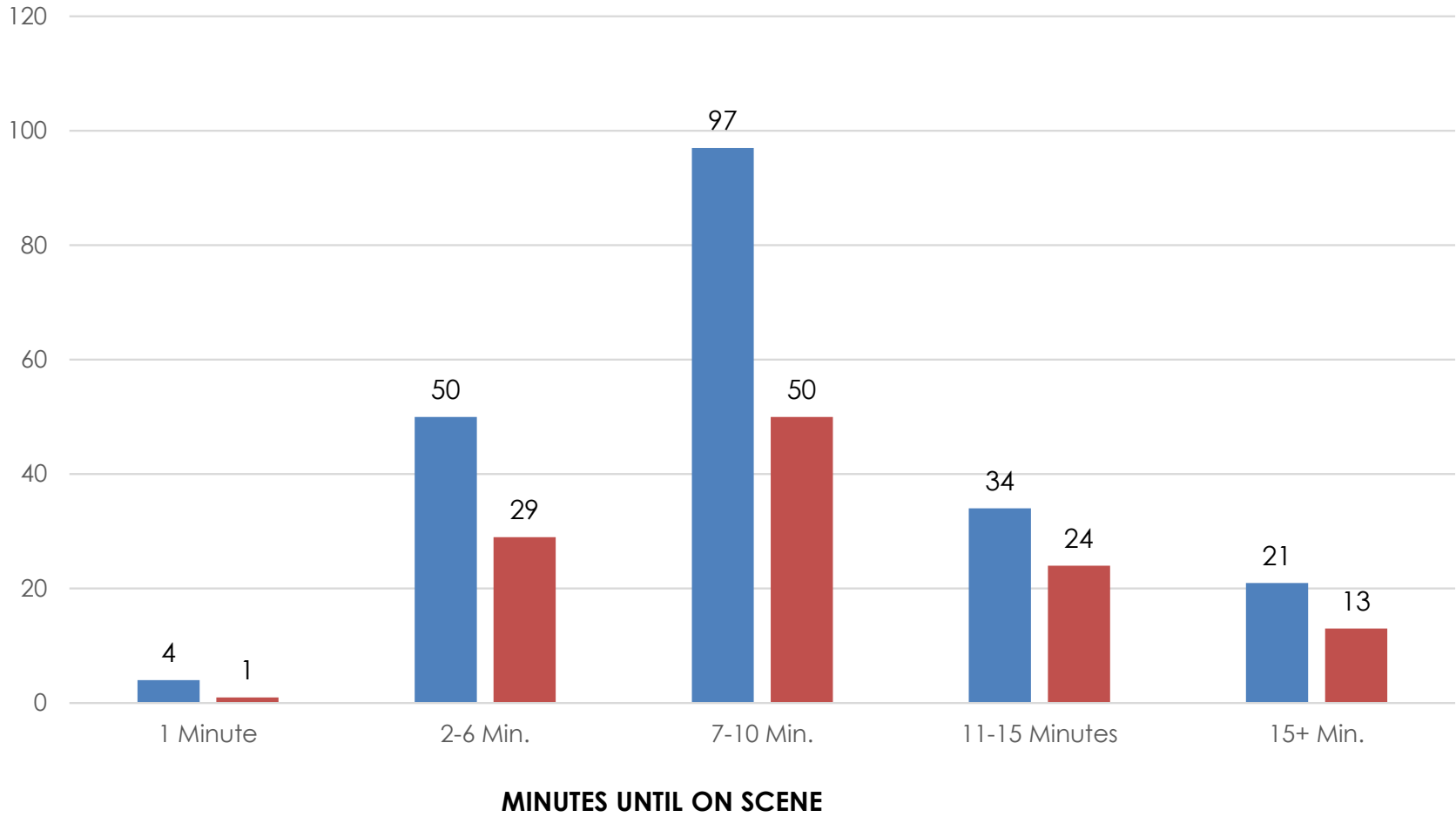

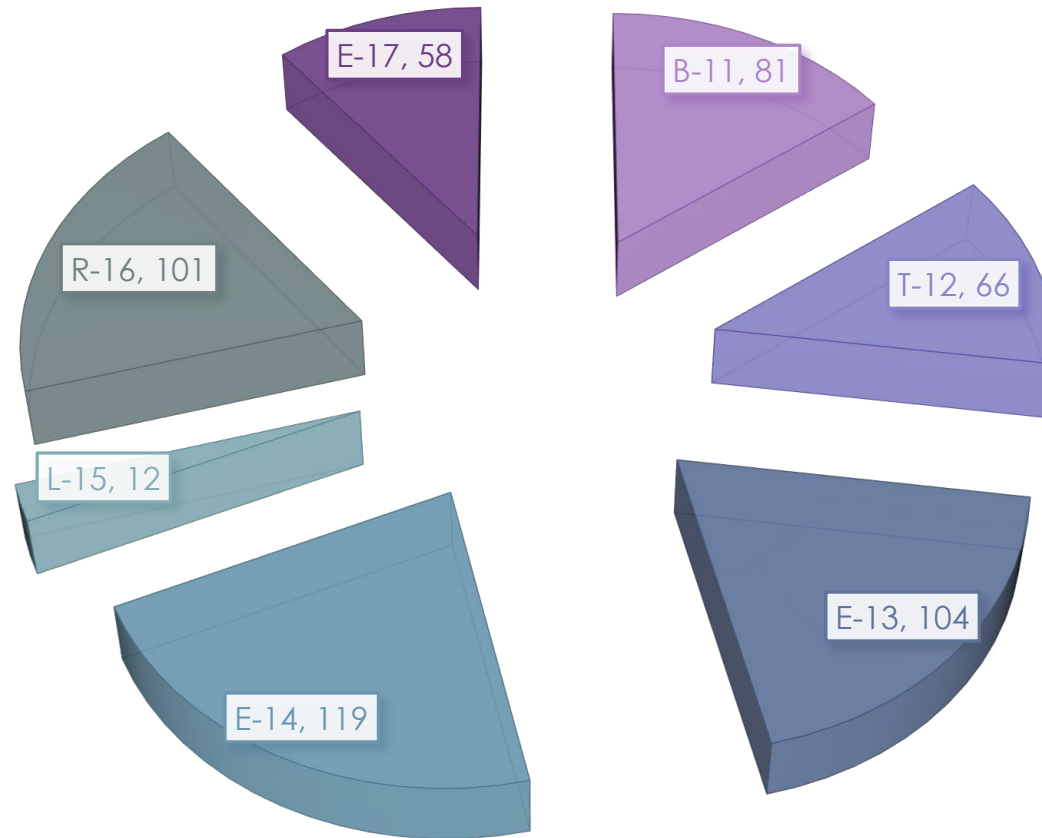
